Consent for works subject to a Tree Preservation Order

Partners

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1. This is an application for consent for works subject to a Tree Preservation Order
2. The title/no. for the relevant Tree Preservation Order is:
11, (A1) Area of Trees
Area of sycamore, beech, ash, elm, cherry, lime, oak and other occasional [sic] species
3. The proposal includes the removal of 3 no. leylandii, 1 no. sycamore and 1 no. Italian Cypress
4. Tree T2 is a self sown, semi mature sycamore. This has a multi stemmed trunk and is having a detrimental effect to the adjacent outbuilding and landscaping.



Fig 1: Multi-stemmed sycamore to north of outbuilding. Uneven crown and previous works to trunks. To be felled.



5. It is proposed to provide a new specimen English Oak (*Quercus robur*) away from the outbuilding, within the rear garden of the property.
6. A number of leylandii have been planted to the south of the house. 2 of the trees are threatening a quality specimen Italian Cypress and a third is providing dense cover to the south east corner of the house. It is proposed all 3 are removed.



Fig 2: Trees T3-T11 from left to Right. T3, T5 and T10 leylandii to be removed. T11 diseased Italian Cypress also to be removed.

7. There is an existing Italian Cypress (*Cupressus sempervirens*) which is diseased and is showing evidence of dead wood. It is proposed this is removed.
8. 3 no. new specimen Italian Cypress Totems will be planted at even spacing around the southern hardstanding to replace the felled trees.
