Hi Matthew,

I have found 2 previous planning applications relating to the building;

-2007/1407 – Change of use of nursing home to twelve bedsits – approved
-2008/0521 – Erection of two, three storey buildings comprising 12no. one bedroomed and 12no. two bedroomed apartments.

With regards to the single storey element, if those units were going to continue to be used for residential purposes (C3) and just subject to refurbishment then planning permission would not be required. However, from the description given there appears to be an element of short term letting (sui Generis) and residential institution (C2) involved, also, the units would not be entirely self-sufficient, they would rely on the two storey element for some cooking facilities, as such, the two parts of the development would be 'linked', rather than independent from each other.

With regards to the two storey element i.e. the COU from residential (C3) to a mixture of offices (class E), Residential Institution (class C2) and hotel/boarded house (class C1) a change of use planning application would be required.

One application could be submitted for all the changes/works including both the single storey and 2 storey elements.
