



To secure Biodiversity Net Gain, one of the following measures will be implemented on site:

1. Wildflower Planting – Establishment of a 50–60m² native wildflower margin in suitable areas within the Scout HQ grounds.
- OR
2. Wildlife Boxes – Installation of 2 bird nest boxes and 1 bat box on suitable structures/trees.
- OR
3. Management – Reduced mowing in selected areas, with wildflower margins cut once annually after seed set.
