

I wish to object to the proposed build for the following reasons -

1. Lack of privacy I live at the top of the site next to the motorway on Drury Farm Court and believe the proposed units behind us will lead to a lack of privacy and a build up of activity. This road is currently private with no through road but we are potentially going to have huge storage units or factory units behind with potentially thousands of people working there and invading the land and space.
2. Lack of clean air - We bought this home knowingly next to a motorway but this new build is being forced upon us with built up houses and huge storage type units within a very near boundary line. At this end of the estate we are already very close to the motorway and this will affect the clean air, noise and level of pollution.
3. Vermin - The storage units will lead to vermin in our gardens and homes something that is a real and increased risk. Unlike the housing estate the storage unit will lead to rubbish and pollution on our backyard something I fully oppose.
4. Increased traffic - Having lived here for 14 years I can give a fair estimate of the level of traffic. A potential increase in thousands of people and hundreds of houses will lead to many more cars and car pollution.
5. A lack of landscape - this proposal will hack into the landscape and ruin the area. Years later the landscape will be unrecognisable and I fully disagree with the plans. This area is fully built up around here and into town, these plans will just build it up further never mind the lack of nature, lack of light, loss of wildlife, lack of oxygen and clean living, loss of house value, increased people, lack of view and why on a scale of this size! Build houses yes but not on this level. Put storage units and factory units out in the outer areas of Barnsley not in people's backyard! The site is just too big! Which hospital will tend these people? I work at Barnsley hospital and already we have ambulances lined up outside - no beds available - no ITU beds, where are the hundreds and thousands going to go for emergency care? Where does this work end on its impact and devastation - build houses yes but don't build huge storage units behind this estate - that's just ridiculous. We paid £150,000 for a small 3 bed end terrace on her 14 years ago - houses on her now go for £300,000 - this is not the place to devalue at this level. Build houses yes but not this on people's doorsteps - be fair and we can support the cause. If the building continues as planned I feel we deserve compensation
