

## Design and Access Statement for the Installation of Palisade Fencing at Raley Street Allotment site, Kingstone, Barnsley

Raley Street allotments are owned and managed by Barnsley MBC. The allotments are leased out to members of the public to grow vegetables and fruit. However in recent years this allotment site has been subject to vandalism and theft.

Groundwork Dearne Valley is working in partnership with BMBC on a project to improve allotments sites across the borough. Raley Street is the ninth site to be improved. Work will include installing a palisade galvanised steel fencing to a height of 2.4m to secure the site. To match with existing fencing on the site the fencing will be a W profile with rounded notched tops and installed by contractors who will dig holes by hand and secure the fence posts in place with cement. Any access tracks onto the allotment will remain accessible.


Any machinery needed for the work will be stored in a secure container or taken back to a secure depot and where possible any materials/waste taken off site will be recycled.

Prior to any work taking place a consultation event will be held by Groundwork Dearne Valley so that local residents and land owners can voice their opinion and views about the proposed work.
