I'm so sorry, I thought I'd done this. However, on checking what I've done is agreed the relevant changes and amendments to the WSI with the applicants archaeological consultant and then not followed up with you. Apologies. Anyway, the WSI has been agreed with me and I would recommend that the following condition is substituted in both applications for the one recommended in my original comments.

'The document "Barnsley West, Barnsley, South Yorkshire Written Scheme of Investigation – Mitigation Strategy including Archaeological Evaluation" Report no. STR01-03 by Prospect Archaeology, dated February 2024, sets out a strategy for archaeological investigation that has been approved in writing on behalf of the Local Planning Authority. The development shall only take place in accordance with the approved Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) unless an updated WSI and timetable has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The development shall not be brought into use until the Local Planning Authority has confirmed in writing that the requirements of the WSI have been fulfilled or alternative timescales agreed.'

Reason:

To ensure that any archaeological remains present, whether buried or part of a standing building, are investigated and a proper understanding of their nature, date, extent and significance gained, before those remains are damaged or destroyed and that knowledge gained is then disseminated.
