

TYPICAL ANNUAL FUNCTION EVENTS

Occasional Christening Gatherings Generally no music '2 No.'

Occasional Weddings with disco '2No.'

Childrens Parties Rarely (not encouraged)

Parties with disco approx.. 1 each month

Christmas Eve Party with disco

New Years Eve Party with disco

CONFIRMATION OF OPENING HOURS

Generally 11am to 11pm

Extensions of time are applied for on Christmas Eve and New Years Eve

MEASURES EXISTING THAT PROVIDE SOUND CONTROL

The premises are well insulated against sound emissions absorbent finishes on walls, ceilings and floors are beneficial in reducing any serious sound reverberation, the bar front is of an absorbent material and furnishings are upholstered having little hard reflective surface

A resident disc jockey is always employed giving continuity in following management instructions regarding volume of sound

It is unnecessary to open windows or doors for ventilation requirements

COMPLAINTS

The management is aware of the complaints concerning loud music, this has been associated with unauthorised openings of primarily emergency doors coinciding with loud disco music

MANAGEMENT PROPOSALS TO PREVENT STATUTORY NOISE

A revised plan arrangement is proposed at the fire exit doors whereby secondary escape doors are introduced forming a lobby which also forms an improvement in privacy to the toilet ares. The revised sketch proposal is attached

CONCLUSIONS

On those occasions when disco music is being played the resident disc jockey will be made responsible for ensuring the emergency exit doors are closed, in the event of these being opened inadvertently by guests he is instructed to immediately cease playing music

The disc jockey is to be further advised should his intention be to play loud music he must go outside the building to assess that the sound falls within statutory limits

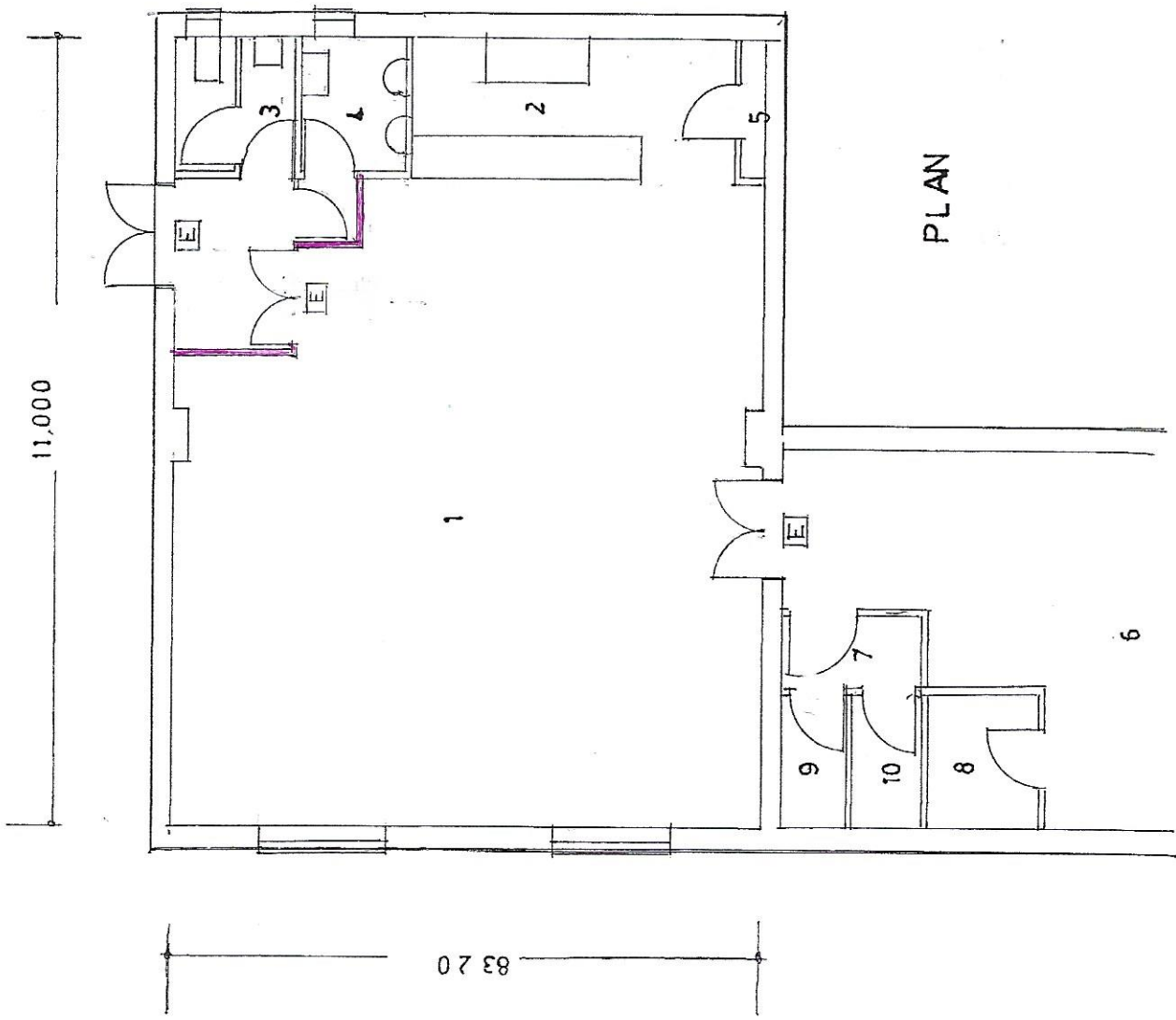
The building itself is very well soundproofed aided by the existing robust construction details, problems have arisen when unauthorised opening of doors takes place, the management purpose is to put in place measures as detailed in the accompanying sketch to ensure the direct access to open air of the existing fire escape doors no longer poses a problem as the proposed porch served by self closing doors will ensure compliance

We trust the statement makes clear the managements intentions to ensure that functions that are held in the future comply with regulatory and good practice
