The proposed ED CAU is an extension to the existing Emergency department (Block C5). We will be stripping the existing emergency entrance canopy of its cladding, and removing the structural cantilever. The proposal is designed to be inclusive of these existing rooms, with new build extension surrounding. Existing curtain walling incl. corrugated metal cladding panels will be stripped out, and new internal partitions be installed between columns. The proposed works will bring together the Children's Emergency Department (ED) and Children's Assessment Unit (CAU) into a co-located integrated model of care to support the rapid turnaround of children using an assessment model in place of a traditional, predominantly inpatient based model. These new ward areas will provide relief from bed pressures in the main hospital, and will modernise the initial experience on the hospital site for those who will attend.
