Comments	
Comments	I formally object to the proposed planning application. My objection is based on the serious potential for increased anti-social behaviour that this development could bring to the community. The proposed development raises the following concerns: Increase in Anti-Social Behaviour: The introduction of the residential care home (for young adults) could result in a significant rise in anti-social activities; including noise, littering, loitering, and public disturbances. These behaviours would have a detrimental effect on the safety and wellbeing of current residents. I can see no evidence in the application that the young adults occupying the proposed home will receive around the clock supervision. Impact on Community Safety: The immediate area is already blighted with documented cases of anti-social activities and criminality, even though good local residents have worked hard to maintain a peaceful and secure environment, especially for young children and families. An increase in anti-social behaviour not only threatens the quality of life for local residents, but also increases the burden on local policing

	and emergency services. Law enforcement (SYP) are already aware of the several cases in the immediate area. Additionally, the development is in walking distance of Worsbrough Bank End Primary School, which raises additional safeguarding issues. Detrimental Effect on Residential Amenity: Anti-social behaviour can lead to reduced enjoyment of local residents homes, lower property values, and a general decline in the character of the neighbourhood. Local goodwill has already been stretched to breaking point, and residents are already in fear of their own and their families personal safety. For the reasons stated above, I strongly object to the granting of this planning permission. I urge the planning authority to consider the negative impact on community cohesion and safety, and to reject the application.
