## 1.0 Introduction

1.1 This report details the results of monthly breeding bird surveys undertaken by Alan Jones and Bill Mottram AES – LTD., supervised by Gary Tudor MCIEEM, AES – LTD. from May through to July 2013 at Hoyland, Nr. Barnsley, South Yorkshire. The site, situated at grid reference SE 355 012 (approximate central point), is an area of open grassland with young mixed plantations, some arable/pasture farmland and a few small ponds within it.

## 2.0 Legislation and policy background

2.1 Birds are afforded various levels of protection and levels of conservation status on a species by species basis, with the inclusion of a number of species on the following legislation or lists of conservation concern:

- Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended) [Department of the Environment (1981)].
- EC Birds Directive 1979 (79/409/EEC).
- UK Biodiversity Action Plan (1995) lists of globally threatened or declining species
- Royal Society for the Protection of Birds (RSPB) Red and Amber Lists of species of conservation concern (RSPB, 2002).

2.2 The most significant general legislation for British birds lies within Part 1 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended). Under this legislation it is an offence to:

- Kill, injure or take any wild bird;
- Take, damage or destroy the nest of any wild bird while that nest is in use or being built;
- Take or destroy an egg of any wild bird.

2.3 In addition to the above protection for breeding birds under the Wildlife and Countryside Act, Schedule 1 of the Act lists a number of species which are protected by special penalties at all times. Annex 1 of the EC Birds Directive also lists rare and vulnerable species of wild birds that are subject to special conservation measures.

The RSPB (2002) has published Red and Amber Lists of species of conservation concern. Red List species are those whose breeding population or range is rapidly declining (50% or more in the last 25 years), recently or historically, and those of global conservation concern. Amber List species are those whose breeding population is in moderate decline (25 – 49% in the last 25 years), rare breeders, internationally important and localised species and those of unfavourable conservation status in Europe.

### **THE UK BIODIVERSITY ACTION PLAN**

- 2.4 The UK Biodiversity Action Plan (BAP) (2007) lists 59 bird species as priority species requiring conservation action, and consequently action plans have been developed for the conservation of these species.

### **[LOCAL] ACTION PLAN**

- 2.5 The Barnsley Biodiversity Action Plan (BAP) (1999) lists 9 bird species as priority species requiring conservation action.

## **3.0 Methods**

- 3.1 Survey design, methodology, fieldwork and assessment has been carried out in accordance with standard guidance Bibby *et al.* 1992<sup>1</sup> and Gilbert *et al.* 1998<sup>2</sup>

### **DATA SEARCH**

- 3.2 A data search was carried out for all faunal/ floral groups and statutory and non-statutory protected sites. Information from the Survey Area and the surrounding area (up to 2km distance from the survey boundary) was requested. This included the following contacts with respect to birds:

- National Biodiversity Network Gateway (NBN)

### **WALKOVER SURVEYS**

- 3.3 During survey visits, a predetermined transect route, was walked at a slow pace so that all birds can be located, identified and recorded using standard British Trust for Ornithology (BTO) notation. Also two vantage points (VP's) were located and a

period of 30 minutes was spent on each VP recording bird activity in the viewable area. Binoculars and telescopes were used throughout to scan the open for the presence of birds. All species are identified by their common name followed by their Latin equivalent. Bird species are listed with their BTO Code and their Conservation Status<sup>3</sup>, if they have red or amber status they are listed as species of conservation concern (SCC). UK Biodiversity Action Plan Species (UKBAP) and Local Biodiversity Action Plan Species (LBAP) are also identified. All birds that were observed during the surveys were recorded including breeding species, passing individuals and species on migration.

- 3.4 Optimal times for breeding bird survey occur between dawn and mid-morning (approximately 10.30am) and from early evening (approximately 5.30pm) to dusk. During these times, breeding birds are more active and can be detected in song more frequently.
- 3.5 Nesting and territorial behaviour (singing, nest building, carrying food, fighting, copulation, nest locations, alarm calling, carrying faecal sacs) were noted by standard codes, as were the age and sex of the birds concerned where observed. Non-nesting behaviour such as over-flying the site was also noted, together with the direction of movement. Birds not considered likely to be nesting on site were still noted where observed.
- 3.6 Results obtained from the walkover survey allowed breeding bird territory distribution and quantity to be estimated. This was achieved by isolating the registrations recorded for a single, selected species in each survey visit, and then plotting all of those registrations together on a single map. The resulting clusters of registrations are then interpreted by an experienced ornithologist to define distinct territories.
- 3.7 One survey per month was undertaken over the breeding season May 2013 to July 2013 for terrestrial habitats. Information obtained from the surveys will help towards building a picture of the general use of the site and its surroundings by all bird species during the non-breeding months.

## 4.0 Results

### DESK STUDY

- 4.1 The NBN Gateway square SE 30 which has the Hoyland area within it returned a total of 720 records and a one year list (2012 to 2013) of 54 species which is shown below in table 1. Note: Please refer to *Hoyland Gateway Full Bird List 2013* for the complete list of 720 records.

## HABITATS

- 4.1 See Phase 1 Habitat Survey for full habitat descriptions, although in summary the site was mainly an area of open grassland with young mixed plantations/hedging, some arable/pasture farmland and a few small ponds within it. A small amount of mature woodland exists in the northwest and southern perimeter edges close to housing. Several small ponds run across the centre of the site in a north to south direction. The A6195 running from the southwest to the northeast splits the site into two fairly equal halves and a newly constructed Industrial Estate lies adjacent to the site in the north.

## BREEDING BIRD SURVEY 2013

- 4.2 Breeding bird surveys were undertaken over one season during 2013. Details of dates, times and weather conditions, are given below in Table 2. The number of hours detailed below is listed per surveyor, for example four hours x two surveyors = total of eight hours survey undertaken.

## BREEDING SPECIES ACCOUNTS 2013

Four Species of Conservation Concern were confirmed breeding, 3 were probable breeders, 4 possible breeders and 7 were non breeders. See Figure 4: Hoyland Breeding Bird Territory Map.

**Moorhen** (*Gallinula chloropus*): Confirmed breeder 1 pair; *wetland*; **(Green)**; high site value; An adult was seen with two chicks on the small pond north of the A6195 during the survey visit in June and another adult bird was noted on the small pond south of the A6195 during the survey visit in July.

**Coot** (*Fulica atra*): Possible breeder; *wetland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; A single bird was noted during the survey visit in May on the small pond south of the A6195 but there were no further sightings.

**Lapwing** (*Vanellus vanellus*): Possible breeder; *wetland / upland / farmland*; **(Red, UK BAP, LBAP)**; high site value; Two birds were seen displaying in pasture land south east of the A6195 during the 1<sup>st</sup> survey in May but there were no further records.

**Herring Gull** (*Larus argentatus*): Non breeder; *farmland / urban / coastal*; **(Red, UK BAP)**; low site value; a single was noted in May flying south west over the site.

**Feral Rock Pigeon** (*Columba livia*): Non breeder; *urban / farmland*; **(Green)**; low site value; A flock of twelve racing pigeons were recorded on two occasions flying around the south western corner of the site.

**Wood Pigeon** (*Columba palumbus*): Confirmed breeder 2 pair; *farmland / woodland*; **(Green)**; high site value; Up to thirteen birds recorded during all of the survey visits across the site with two nests found in the woodland area in the north.

**Collared Dove** (*Streptopelia decaocto*): Possible breeder; *urban / farmland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; There was just a single sighting of one bird within trees close to the Industrial Estate in the north.

**Swift** (*Apus apus*) Non breeder; *urban / farmland*; **(Amber)**; low site value; Up to eleven birds were occasionally noted flying around the site from June onwards.

**Green Woodpecker** (*Picus viridis*): Possible breeder; *woodland / farmland*; **(Amber)**; moderate site value; A family of five birds were seen on the last survey visit in July within trees close to a group of houses in the north. There had been no sightings prior to this and it was deemed likely that the birds had probably bred in the mature woodland adjacent to the site in the north.

**Great Spotted Woodpecker** (*Dendrocopus major*): Possible breeder; *woodland / farmland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; Two birds were noted during the last survey visit in July on a telegraph pole close to a group of houses in the north.

**Skylark** (*Alauda arvensis*): Confirmed breeder 3 pair; *farmland/ grassland*; **(Red, UK BAP, LBAP)**; high site value; Several birds seen and heard singing on the western side of the site within the grassland areas with a maximum survey count of six birds in May and a juvenile noted in July.

**Barn Swallow** (*Hirundo rustica*): Non breeder; *farmland*; **(Amber)**; moderate site value; Up to seven birds usually found flying around the southern half of the site close to some offsite stables where breeding presumably took place. .

**Meadow Pipit** (*Anthus pratensis*): Confirmed breeder 1 pair; *farmland / upland*; **(Amber)**; high site value; Two territorial birds were noted within grassland in the south west corner of the site and four birds which included at least two juveniles were seen there in July.

**Pied Wagtail** (*Motacilla alba*): Possible breeder; *farmland / urban*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; Two birds were seen foraging together in a house garden at the northern perimeter of the site during the survey visit in June.

**Wren** (*Troglodytes troglodytes*): Probable breeder; *farmland / woodland / urban*; **(Green)**; high site value; Up to three birds were heard singing across the site within suitable wooded habitat but there was no evidence of breeding success.

**Dunnock** (*Prunella modularis*): Possible breeder; *farmland / woodland / urban*; **(Amber, UK BAP)** high site value; Occasional sightings of single birds around the site close to human habitation with two singing birds noted during the survey visit in May.

**Robin** (*Erithacus rubecula*): Confirmed breeder 4 pair; *woodland / urban*; **(Green)**; high site value; Up to seven birds found singing across the site in suitable wooded areas with two juveniles recorded during the survey visit in July.

**Blackbird** (*Turdus merula*): Confirmed breeder 4 pair; *woodland / farmland / urban*; **(Green)**; high site value; Found in suitable wooded/scrub habitat across the site with a maximum survey count of eleven birds during the visit in July. Juveniles recorded from June onwards.

**Song Thrush** (*Turdus philomelos*): Probable breeder; *woodland / farmland*; **(Red, UK BAP)**; high site value; An individual sang during all of the survey visits in tall trees close to a group of houses in the northern area of the site.

**Mistle Thrush** (*Turdus viscivorus*): Non breeder; *woodland / farmland*; **(Amber)**; moderate site value; There was just one record of a single bird seen foraging on the ground in the western corner of the site.

**Blackcap** (*Sylvia atricapilla*): Confirmed breeder 2 pair; *woodland / scrub*; **(Green)**; high site value; up to three birds noted singing across the site in suitable wooded/scrub habitat with a group of three juveniles recorded during the survey visit in July.

**Garden Warbler** (*Sylvia borin*): Confirmed breeder 1 pair; *woodland*; **(Green)**; high site value; two singing birds were recorded on 16th May within suitable scrubby habitat in the northern corner of the site with three juveniles noted during the survey visit in July.

**Lesser Whitethroat** (*Sylvia curruca*): Possible breeder; *scrub / farmland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value. During the survey in May two singing males were noted in the northern corner of the site within dense shrubbery. No evidence of breeding, but due to this species very skulking behaviour, it was highly possible.

**Whitethroat** (*Sylvia communis*): Confirmed breeder 3 pair; *scrub / farmland*; **(Amber)** high site value; Up to four singing birds were noted across the site in suitable scrubby areas with four juveniles recorded within a tit/warbler flock during the last survey visit in July.

**Chiffchaff:** (*Phylloscopus collybita*): Probable breeder; *woodland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; A single male was found singing within some mature trees in the far northern corner of the site in June and July.

**Willow Warbler** (*Phylloscopus trochilus*): Confirmed breeder 12 pair; *woodland / scrub*; **(Amber)**; high site value; Commonest warbler on site with a total of seventeen singing birds noted during the survey visit in May and usually found in the young plantation areas. Five juveniles were noted within a tit/warbler flock in July.

**Blue Tit** (*Parus caeruleus*): Confirmed breeder 1 pair; *woodland / urban*; **(Green)**; high site value; A family with recently fledged young were noted in mature woodland along the northern boundary during the survey visit in June. Also a total of twenty six birds which included mostly juveniles were found to be feeding within the young plantation areas during the survey visit in July.

**Great Tit** (*Parus major*): Confirmed breeder 1 pair; *woodland*; **(Green)**; high site value; Up to nine birds noted across the site with a family group of five birds recorded during the survey visit in June within mature trees alongside a row of houses next to the northern boundary.

**Willow Tit** (*Parus montanus*): Non breeder; *woodland*; **(Red, UK BAP)**; moderate site value; Three juveniles were seen amongst a group of other tit species and warblers feeding within a young plantation just south of the A6195 during the survey visit in July.

**Magpie** (*Pica pica*): Possible breeder; *woodland/ scrub/ urban*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; Up to six birds were recorded during all of the surveys mainly foraging in the western and southern open areas but there was no indication of breeding onsite.

**Jackdaw** (*Corvus monedula*): Non breeder; *urban / woodland*; **(Green)**; low site value; Up to thirty six birds recorded foraging on open ground with other corvid species and usually within the south-western corner of the site.

**Rook** (*Corvus frugilegus*): Non breeder; *woodland / farmland*; **(Green)**; low site value; Normally found foraging in the south-western corner of the site amongst other corvid species with thirty four birds noted during the survey in June.

**Carrion Crow** (*Corvus corone*): Possible breeder; *woodland / farmland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; Common bird on site and found during every visit either foraging in fields or resting in the trees with the highest counts being forty one birds during the survey visits in May and July. Possibly bred in the woodland/plantation areas but no nests were found.

**Starling** (*Sturnus vulgaris*): Non breeder; *urban / woodland*; **(Red, UK BAP)**; low site value; Up to seven birds were seen foraging on the ground in the south-western corner of the site during the survey visits in May and June.

**House Sparrow** (*Passer domesticus*): Non breeder; *urban / farmland*; **(Red, UK BAP)**; low site value; During the survey visits in June and July two birds were seen close to a group of houses adjacent to the northern boundary where breeding probably took place.

**Chaffinch** (*Fringilla coelebs*): Confirmed breeder 3 pair; *woodland / farmland / urban*; **(Green)**; high site value; commonest finch on site and recorded during all of the visits within suitable wooded/hedgerow habitat with the highest count being six birds in May. Juvenile birds noted during the survey visit in July.

**Goldfinch** (*Carduelis carduelis*): Probable breeder; *scrub / farmland*; **(Green)**; moderate site value; during the survey visits in May and June two birds were seen in suitable scrubby habitat close to a group of houses adjacent to the northern boundary but there was no evidence of breeding success.

**Linnet** (*arduelis cannabina*): Probable breeder; *farmland / scrub* **(Red, UK BAP)**; high site value; a pair was seen in suitable scrubby habitat close to the northern boundary during May and June but there was no evidence of breeding success.

**Yellowhammer** (*Emberiza citrinella*): Possible breeder; *farmland / heathland*; **(Red, UK BAP)** high site value; A singing male was noted in May and July in or close to hedgerow running along the north western boundary but there was no evidence of breeding success.

**Reed Bunting** (*Emberiza schoeniclus*): Probable breeder; *wetland/ farmland/ heathland*; **(Amber, UK BAP)**; high site value; up to four singing males were

recorded close to the small ponds but there was no evidence of any breeding success.


## 5.0 Discussion

- 5.1 A total of 40 species were recorded on the site. Bird species diversity was considered to be moderate due to the area being mainly comprised of open grass land with young mixed plantations a few small ponds and a small amount of mature woodland around it. Also the majority of the site was open to the public by means of numerous paths and therefore the disturbance level was quite high.
- 5.2 Species recorded were predominately farmland and woodland birds with confirmed breeding of the following species of conservation concern Skylark, Meadow Pipit, Whitethroat and Willow Warbler. Probable breeders included Song Thrush, Linnet and Reed Bunting. A pair of Lapwing, the only wader species encountered, was seen displaying in pasture during the 1<sup>st</sup> survey visit in May but there were no more sightings thereafter and the birds had presumably moved on. There were no records of Raptors or Owls.
- 5.3 The grassland areas held three pairs of Skylark and one pair of Meadow Pipits with a family of Green Woodpeckers noted during the last survey in July within the mature woodland on the northern perimeter. The young mixed plantations held up to seventeen singing Willow Warblers and were also found to be excellent feeding areas for family groups of birds such as Tits and Warblers.






