DESCRIPTION:

Proposed temporary modular classrooms

BACKGROUND:

Hoylandswaine Primary School is an old Victorian building situated in the village of Hoylandswaine along Haigh Lane and Cross Lane. Currently the old kitchen in to the front of the school is in need of upgrading and a new hall is required for school dinners.

BRIEF AND DESIGN PRINCIPALS:

This proposal is to provide a new kitchen and dining hall for the school. The hall and kitchen extension shall be accessible via the back of the school and the school playground. School deliveries shall be done out of hours off Cross Lane where there is a pair of gates.

The kitchen extension shall include kitchen; storage office and changing room. The hall extension shall include hall; PE store; toilets and accessible toilet block. There is also a corridor link to the main school. All the entrance points to the new extension to have level access to comply with current DDA regulations.

There is no increase in staff or numbers of children only new facilities.
