The development of the square is of a high quality with a coordinated palette of materials and planting scheme, the square includes benches, a number of water fountains and a large sculpture on loan from the Yorkshire Sculpture Park 'Vertical by Nigel Hall'.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

A series of seven glass 'columns'. Each column will include a number of toughened and laminated low-iron glass layers each with text and images on each face of the glass using sand blasting, mirror and no treatment to create a lace-like effect.  
The front and back surfaces will feature matt translucent 'frosted' text.  
The middle (laminated) surface will feature silvered text on a clear base. Opaque printed text could also feature in this layer.  
Each panel will be fixed in a stainless steel fixing at ground level that is set within a concrete foundation.

A concrete foundation will be inserted into the column locations within the planting areas by qualified professionals. Metal casings will be secured into the concrete foundation and bolted on using tamper proof bolts. The columns will then be resin bonded into the metal casing with a water-proof sealant to avoid water damage. Any disturbed or damaged planting will then be made good to conceal the concrete foundation and disguise the metal casing.
