1. Staff parking spaces – typical provision of three spaces for staff vehicles.
2. Citroën Berlingo wheelchair-accessible pool car. Normally parked in this position. Can be moved to space 3 for loading/unloading if preferred, or to free the space for a fourth staff vehicle when required. Wheelchair loading and unloading is also possible here.
3. Designated accessible parking bay kept available for visiting wheelchair users (block-paved, material TBC). Firm, level surface suitable for wheelchair users, with signage on the adjacent wall and fencing.
4. Visitor parking spaces available for relatives, carers, visiting professionals and deliveries.
5. Electronically operated sliding gate to the western driveway (held open during daytime hours and staff handover periods; closed overnight for security).
6. New paved pedestrian access paths providing level, firm and even routes between parking areas, entrances and the accessible bay.
