I object to the outline planning for application number 2021/1090 for the following reasons

1 the closure of hermit lane will increase my carbon foot print because i will have to travel further to the hospital and also into town centre,

2 we were promised that higham common road would be closed off at the south end just after the motorway bridge and be accessed from the new link road via hermit lane thus making it for residents only thus reducing traffic this is not happening,

3 you are building on green space against government policy why not build on brown land there is plenty within the borough ,

4 the plan of building affordable housing will lower values of existing houses by having DHSS people and vagabonds living in our village,

5 the roads around the proposed site are not capable of taking the increase in volume in traffic 1760 new homes average of 1.5 cars per house would give 2640 cars using the roads plus all the industrial vehicles will create grid lock plus all the pollution they would bring this goes against the councils latest green policy,
