



REFERENCE

- Existing trees to be retained
- Existing trees to be removed
- Proposed standard tree planting.
- Proposed hedgerow planting. Double staggered row of hawthorn, blackthorn, holly, dog rose, planted at 6 per linear metre.
- Proposed woodland planting. Mix of 80% transplants and 20% feathered trees planted at 1.5m centres. Species chosen from Oak, ash, birch, lime, whitebeam, rowan, crab apple, wild cherry, hazel, holly
- Existing acid grassland/ heath vegetation. Retained and managed by grazing up young sedge and purple cutting on a rotational basis, every 5-7 years
- Proposed acid grassland and heath. Created by seeding an appropriate mix of seed of local provenance on to a nutrient poor substrate. Managed as above to develop and maintain a grass/heather habitat.
- Proposed hay or grazing meadows currently in decline in the area. A 60% grass/ 20% sedge and 20% heath seed mix of local provenance. Mix to be created from seed once or twice per year, taking cuttings off to prevent build up of fertility.
- Proposed long grass and scrub margins. Allowed to develop naturally by a management regime of mowing every 3-5 years on a rotational basis
