A61 Phase 1 Old Mill Lane: Discharge of Conditions

Application reference 2021/1660 – The widening of Old Mill Lane Bridge and Gyratory to accommodate four traffic lanes, an inbound bus lane and shared cycle/ pedestrian pathway on both sides of the highway.

On behalf of South Yorkshire Passenger Transport Executive, please find enclosed details to discharge conditions of planning permission 2021/1660. The application relates to the widening of Old Mill Lane Bridge and Gyratory to accommodate four traffic lanes, an inbound bus lane and a shared cycle/ pedestrian pathway on both sides of the highway.

- Plans/ Drawings showing proposed highway and bridge engineering design/ construction and drainage.



The application seeks approval of details relating to the following conditions:

- Condition 3 – Foul and surface water drainage details
- Condition 4 – Written Scheme of Investigation
- Condition 7 – Construction Method Statement
- Condition 8 – Highway and bridge design details
- Condition 9 – Highway engineering construction details

The details of information to discharge each condition are set out below:

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Condition 3

Condition 3 sets out a requirement for full foul and surface water drainage details to be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority prior to any development taking place.

Please find the full foul and surface water drainage details on the enclosed drawings which are referenced below:

Condition 4

Condition 5 sets out a requirement for a Written Scheme of Investigation that sets out a strategy for archaeological investigation to be submitted and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

Please find enclosed a Written Scheme of Investigation, prepared by Archaeological Service WYAS for South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority. It provides details of the archaeological watching brief to be undertaken at the site.

Condition 7

Condition 7 sets out a requirement for a Construction Method Statement to be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority.

Please find enclosed a People, Vehicle and Plant Management Plan, prepared by Balfour Beatty. This sets out the arrangements that are required to be followed to ensure that the risks involved in the movement of vehicles and plant and the interface with site personnel are identified and controlled as far as reasonably practicable.

Condition 8

The wording of Condition 8 states as follows:

'Prior to any works commencing on site full details shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority that secure the following works:

- *Highway engineering*
- *Bridge widening*
- *Provision of / any alterations to highway drainage*
- *Provision of / any alterations to street lighting*
- *Any necessary signing / lining details*

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- *Any necessary resurfacing / reconstruction*
- *Measures to prevent/control parking and loading*
- *Provision of / any alterations to bus stops*
- *Signal controlled pedestrian crossing and signal controls*

The works shall subsequently be constructed in accordance with the approved details and timetable to be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority.'

Please find the highway and bridge design details on the enclosed drawings.


Condition 9

Please find the engineering construction details on the enclosed drawings.
