Locations of trees

There are four tree's that we would like to remove from the rear garden (please see associated drawing) Tree 1 and 2 sit well within the boundary of the rear garden and tree 3 is located on the eastern boundary of the property but still within the clients land. Tree 4 is located on the west side of the garden next to the walled garden wall.

Tree Ownership

My client Mark Ludlam is the owner of the trees stated.

What are we applying for?

We would like to apply for the removal of the 4 trees listed below:

T1 Holly

T2 Cherry

T3 Pine

T4 Silver Lime

Reasons for removal

T1 Holly – This tree is generally in poor health. It appears to have an historic graft which could become unstable over time. The right-hand limb on the path side has pocket of decay to the base of the limb. Throughout the tree there are further pocket of decay and tree wound from previous formalisations. It is now too late to re-formalise the tree and doing this could make it unstable.

Description of tree work required – **Complete removal**

T2 Cherry – Like the holly tree the cherry also appears to be in poor health there are several pockets of decay and from appearance due to age seems to be coming to the end of its life. Due to its unhealthy appearance this tree also offers no visual merit to the existing of proposed garden.

Description of tree work required – **Complete removal**

T3 Pine – The pine tree is currently growing in very close proximity/through the existing oak tree this has likely a self-seeded specimen. We would like to remove this to preserve the health of the oak tree before any damaged is cause to this specimen.

Description of tree work required – **Complete removal**

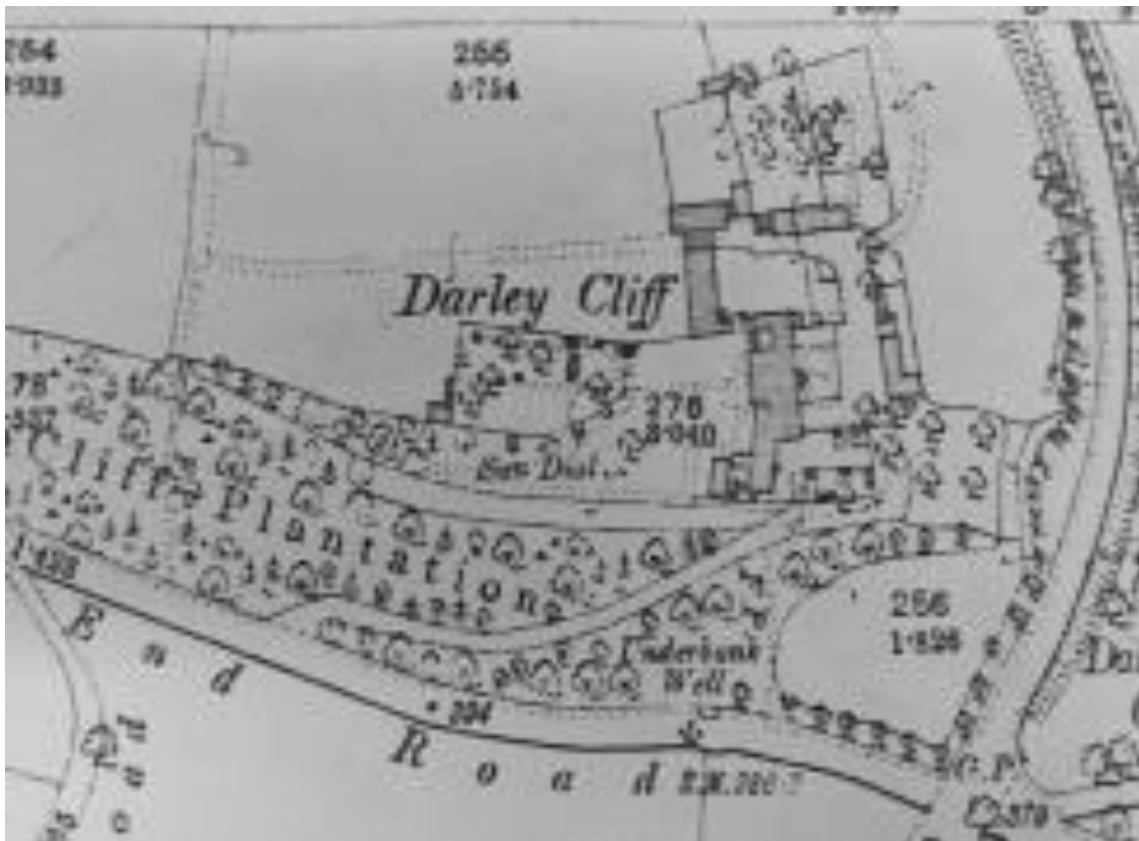
T4 Silver Lime

This has a large, weakened inclusion from a sub dominant stem and needs to be removed.

Description of tree work required – **Complete removal**

Planting replacement tree's

For the 4 tree's we would like to remove we proposed planting 10 new native deciduous trees within the garden (please see supporting drawing for new tree locations) These new tree's will be planted in recognition to restore the plantation walk shown on early maps of the garden (see below 1890's map showing tree in south west of garden)
