T1	Cherry	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T2	Ash	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T4	Cherry	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T5	Ash	Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T6	Beech	Prune on east side by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain 6m ground clearance over site
T7	Elm	Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T8	Cherry	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T9	Ash	Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T10	Ornamental damson	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T11	Ash	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m

T13	Ornamental damson	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T14	Swedish whitebeam	Prune by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches of up to 100mm diameter to obtain 5m ground clearance over site
T15	Swedish whitebeam	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T16	Cherry	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T17	Golden Leyland cypress	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T18	Ash	Prune by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain 4m ground clearance over site
T19	Cherry	Prune by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain 3m ground clearance over site
T21	Beech	Prune by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches of up to 100mm diameter to obtain 5m ground clearance over site
T22	Turkey oak	Prune by removal or shortening of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain 7m ground clearance over site
T23	Copper beech	Prune by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches of up to 150mm diameter to obtain 5m ground clearance
T24	Turkey oak	Prune by removal of low first order branches of up to 100mm diameter to obtain 5m ground clearance over site
T25	Swedish whitebeam	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T26	Swedish whitebeam	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T27	Ash	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T28	Cherry	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T29	Ash	Prune on north side by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain 3.5m ground clearance over site
T30	Horse chestnut	Prune on north side by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain 3.5m ground clearance over site
T31	Swedish whitebeam	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T32	Swedish whitebeam	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T33	Turkey oak	Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
T34	Copper beech	Prune on south west side by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches of up to 150mm diameter to obtain 5m ground clearance over site
T36	Swedish whitebeam	Fell and grub out or grind stump to a depth of 0.3m
G1	Elder & Elm	Prune on east side back to boundary
G2	Ornamental conifers	Remove and grub out or grind stumps to a depth of 0.3m
G3	3 Hawthorn	Prune by removal of basal shoots and low lateral branches to obtain 2m ground clearance
G4	3 Turkey oak	G4/2 & G4/3 - Prune by removal of low lateral and sub-lateral branches of up to 180mm diameter to obtain ground clearance of between 4 and 5m
G7	Horse chestnut Ornamental damson Holly Hawthorn Elder	Hard prune on north side to reduce height and radial crown spread into site
G9	2 Turkey oak	Prune by removal or shortening of low lateral and sub-lateral branches to obtain between 4.5 and 6m ground clearance
G11	Ornamental conifers	Remove and grub out or grind stumps to a depth of 0.3m
G12	2 Turkey oak	G12/1 – Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.2m
G13	3 Turkey oak	G13/1 – Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.2m
G14	2 Ash	G14/1 - Fell and grind stump to a depth of 0.2m
H1	Leyland cypress Elder	Cut back to boundary
H2	Leyland cypress Cherry laurel Golden Leyland cypress	Cut back to boundary
H3	Cherry laurel	Cut back to reduce height and spread
H4	Leyland cypress Hawthorn Ash	Cut back to boundary
H5	Holly Elder	Cut back to boundary
H6	Lawson's cypress	Hard prune by up to 30% to reduce height and spread
H7	Hawthorn Holly Elder	Prune on north side back to boundary
