In pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and Regulations the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council as the Local Planning Authority hereby grants consent for the proposals the subject of the plan(s) and application registered by the Council on the 06 February 2009 and therein described as:- Crown lift 3-4m, 10% canopy thin and deadwood Horse Chestnut (T2) and crown lift 3-4m and deadwood Sycamore (T1) within TPO No. 3/2006. 28 High Street, Thurnscoe, Rotherham, S63 0SU.

Consent is subject to compliance with the following conditions:-

- 1 Five days notice to LPA and tree surgery to BS standards

Not less than five working days notice of the date of the proposed work shall be given in writing to the Local Planning Authority and the tree surgery shall be carried out to the standards set out in BS3998.

**Reason: To ensure the work accords with good arboricultural practice in accordance with Policy GS22 of the adopted Unitary Development Plan and SPG9 (Trees and Hedgerows).**

- 2 Time limit for TPO works

The proposed tree works should be completed within 2 years of the date of this consent. Any required replanting should be carried out in the planting season immediately following the tree felling.

**Reason: To ensure that adequate notice is given for the works to be inspected and approved by the Local Planning Authority.**
