

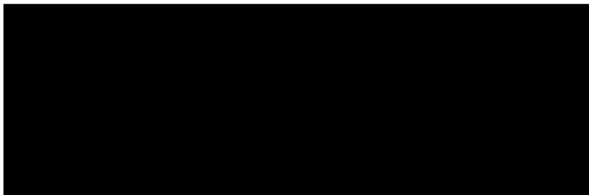
Heritage Statement: 14 Regent Street, Barnsley, S70 2HG

History and Listing

14 Regent Street is a Grade II Listed building (List Entry 1191936). The building is thought to date from around 1825 and is constructed with dressed stonework walls surmounted by a pitched roof covered with Welsh slates. The front entrance is a doric door case with fluted columns and open modillion pediments. The entrance doorway has semi-circular fan lights with radial glazing bars.

The proposal is to change the existing signage to the front of the building following a rebranding.

Informal discussions have taken place with Mr Tony Wiles, the Conservation Officer for Barnsley MBC, who has approved in principle the design and materials.
