3. Description of Proposed Works

Please describe the proposals to alter, extend or demolish the listed building(s):

The proposals look to safeguard the existing museum and education spaces in their current guise.
New WC facilities
One of the issues with the current facilities was the lack of WC 's in the near vicinity. The existing WC's are located on the floor above, with children currently chaperoned up the staircase to use the facilities and wedding parties having an even greater distance to travel.
The proposals are to provide new Male & Female WC facilities, Disabled WC and Baby Change Room within the basement to alleviate the current problems.
The WC facilities are proposed to be sited within 2 existing store rooms and have the drainage pumped via a saniflow system to the upper existing adjacent drainage that runs along the front of the building.
Plasterboard partition walls are proposed to divide up the 4 spaces.
The toilet facilities will comprise of an IPS system with concealed cisterns, free standing WC cubicles and vanity units.
Any mechanical extract / ventilation will be routed to external walls by means of the existing walled up windows below the light wells.
An existing steel framed structure is currently sited within one of the storerooms that houses paintings. This can be easily dismantled to provide a clear space for the toilet works.
Classroom / Educational Facility
The existing kitchen / educational facility require updating and it is proposed to install new storage units with 2 dual height sinks.
Existing vinyl flooring to be removed and new wood effect vinyl installed.
Existing timber panelled storage cupboards to be retained and refurbished along with the window seats storage.

3. Description Proposed Works (continued)

Corridor areas and Staircase

Over the years various services have been added and decommissioned leaving an array of pipework and wiring throughout the corridor areas. The proposal is to remove any redundant pipework and wiring, relocate any services away from the museum areas to create a more appropriate space. The corridor spaces will then be redecorated. Existing stone flags within the staircase area have become worn to a point where they are a trip hazard. It is intended to undertake repair works to these areas using a suitable conservation technique.

The staircase and balustrade are to be refurbished and decorated.

Museum Kitchen, Pantry Kitchen & Larder

These areas are proposed to be redecorated only with a heritage colour yet to be determined

The existing biomass boiler pipework that pass through the pantry kitchen are proposed to be hidden via a timber L shaped boxing at height level connecting to the underside of the staircase.

Servants Dining Room

This area has inadequate lighting and it is proposed to install new pendant lights in keeping with the era but with the facility to dim if required.
