### Consultation Assessment and Justification

This proposal involves the removal of an existing BT payphone box and the installation of a new BT Street Hub. The Hub design is slimmer and takes a more compact profile than the existing BT payphone boxes being replaced; as such, whilst the HDC officers would wish to see street clutter reduced, there would be no justification for objecting to the scheme on these grounds as there is no overall increase in street furniture.

The Street Hub is positioned in a pedestrianised precinct on a wide section of pavement without impeding pedestrian or delivery vehicle movements with ample footway width being retained.

The scheme is acceptable from the perspective of highway development control. However, the council's Highway Network Co-ordination team would require a streetworks permit for the installation of the Hub and may raise their own concerns regarding the application at this time.
