The main body of the building are stone/render two storeys with dual pitched stone slate roof and is divided into three properties, with detached two storey dual pitched garage to the north aspect (side) of the building.

Description of the Proposals

The proposal is for our client Mr M. Bower to construct a garden building within the garden of his property, however since permitted development rights have been revoked following the earlier planning approval as noted in planning reference number 2020/0147, condition 4.

While the garden building has been designed within the general guidance for permitted development, to ensure openness of the greenbelt is maintained, the intention of this application is to ensure the proposed development is acceptable to the planning authority and to conform with the condition of the earlier planning approval.

We have included plans and elevations of the garden building with relevant dimensions that confirm the garden building does not exceed the properties former development rights. We would also note that currently the location of the proposed garden building has a 4m high hedge to the boundary therefore openness will not be affected by this proposal.
