The residential property has been in the applicant's ownership since August 2024 when it was marketed and purchased as such. Records indicate it has been occupied as a dwelling since October 2000 when it was first constructed.

The style, vernacular and layout all indicate the property was purpose designed and constructed as a dwelling.

There is one previous planning application associated with the dwelling in 1999 for the develop of the housing estate only. It is noted that no conditions were imposed with these decision notices to remove the permitted development rights of the property.

The proposal consists of a single-storey rear extension to an existing detached dwelling, with the developed area around the property not exceeding 50%, with a depth as measured from the existing rear wall of the property not exceeding 3.0m, with an eaves height of no greater than 3.0m as within 2.0m of the boundary and overall not exceeding 4.0m at any point.

The proposals do not include any new verandas, antennae, chimneys but do include alterations of the flue & soil pipe.

There are no alterations to the existing roof of the existing property.

The property is not on designated land.

The materials proposed, stone blockwork, is of a similar appearance to those of the current rear elevations, stone blockwork.
