#### Background information

In the light of the damaged nature of the application site it has not been considered necessary to acquire any further detail of the heritage assets likely to have been contained within the site area. The Archaeological Officer for South Yorkshire confirms the conclusion reached in this review (e-mail of 1.09.2014, 13.07):

‘Thank you for sending on the further information. I agree that the extent of previous disturbance coupled with the small area of potential impact from the proposed development amount to a fairly negligible impact upon the historic environment. In these circumstances, I do not think that any archaeological investigation would be fruitful and I will recommend to Barnsley Planning that no further work is required. ‘

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
