Informative(s):

This application for a certificate of lawfulness for an existing use only relates to a Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) use which is a small, shared house occupied by between three and six unrelated individuals, as their only or main residence, who share basic amenities such as a kitchen or bathroom. If more than six unrelated individuals reside in the property at any point, then a change of use application from Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) to Sui Generis would be required

Please be aware that the Council monitors construction sites and open land within the vicinity of such sites in an attempt to prevent fly tipping (i.e. unauthorised deposit of waste on land), which is illegal under the Environmental Protection Act 1990. The penalties for fly-tipping can include:

- a fine of up to £50,000 and
- up to six months imprisonment on conviction.

Therefore, if necessary, please ensure that all demolition waste and waste associated with the construction of any development is disposed of via approved methods and that documents are retained to prove this.
