Regarding the pre application Enquiry for Phoenix Works that you have supplemented with a plan showing two alternative schemes I have the following comments to make.

This is an existing Industrial estate so commercial building here would be acceptable in principle and as such the main issues would relate to detailed matters.

I have received the following comments from Highways

The proposed access would be satisfactory as approach speeds are restrained by the tight bend to the east of the site, subject to clearance of the overgrown verge bordering the site. The alternative arrangement shown, with access from Barrowfield Road, is a much preferable scheme.

Subject to the above, there are no objections in principle on highway development control grounds at this stage.

From a planning perspective the main issues would be to ensure that external storage is controlled so that the appearance from the surrounding roads is not prejudiced. This can be achieved via the use of suitable boundary screening but also by ensuring that no stacking of goods occurs.

5. Pre-application Advice

In terms of the application you will need to address the matters of ecology and drainage by providing a short statement and some indication of your proposals for SUDs if the site is over 0.5 hectare or the buildings are more than 1000m2.

You would also be advised to indicate whether there would be any opportunity to incorporate renewables within the scheme.

Given the location on an industrial estate a noise report may not be needed but hours of operation should be specified and some indication of the uses that would be in the buildings (B1,B2 or B8). If there are specific processes such as a vehicle testing rolling rack then this may cause elevated noise levels.
