General Precautions

To be observed by all staff at all times, any deviation from these control procedures must be authorised by the site foreman or safety representative.

Contractor and Visitor Safety

A.Deakin Developments Ltd will liaise with other contractors staff on a day to day basis and ensure they are aware of the risks present during the works. Staff and contractors will not leave any area of work in a dangerous condition or with risks to themselves, other contractors, tenants, or visitors, all tools and equipment will be cleared to secure storage at the completion of each shift. Heavy plant, scaffold, ladders and any other access to height will be made inaccessible.

Erection and Maintenance of security hoarding including decorative displays and facilities for public viewing

Temporary security fencing will be erected around the site boundaries and entrance, as well as for the protection of any trees specified in the survey and tree protection plan. Daily inspections of the site, fencing and signage will be recorded and any remedial work will be rectified immediately. Safety signs will be in full view on the Sheffield Road side and around the boundaries of the site.

Loading and unloading of Plant and Materials

Loading and unloading of plant materials will be done on site. RAMS and the Health and Safety policy will be adhered to to ensure public and operative safety. Loading/ unloading will only take place during the specified times 0800 to 1800 weekdays and 0900 to 1400 Saturdays.

Means of Access for Construction Traffic

All construction traffic will access to and from the site via the Sheffield Road entrance adjacent to the chemist. Construction traffic will be active from 0800 to 1800 weekdays and 0900 to 1400 on Saturdays. In the interest of public and highway safety, banksmen will be used on and off the site. Clear signs will be displayed to prevent parking at the site entrance or public parking on site.

Measure to control the emission of dust, dirt and noise during construction.

RAMS, Health and Safety Policy, Environment policy to be adhered to and given on induction. Security fencing to be covered with netting to prevent the spread of dust and dirt. Dust extractors used when possible and wet cutting to minimise dust. Noise will be kept to a minimum to prevent disruption to neighbouring dwellings and businesses. Site hours will be adhered to at all times as per planning specifications.

Parking of Vehicles of Site Operatives and Visitors

Parking for site operatives and visitors will be onsite. Parking areas will be constructed and turning bays formed. Information will be given in sign form on access to the site as well as communicated with suppliers and sub-contractors.

Storage of plant and materials used in constructing the development.

Allocated areas will be given for the safe storage of plant and materials on site. This will be adhering to the specifications in the RAMS, to minimise any risk to the public or operatives. There will also be a secured cabin on site.

Wheel Washing Facilities

Wheel washing facilities will be provided on site and area allocated and signed. Wheel washing will be completed on site to minimise disruption and soilage/ unsightliness to the highways and surrounding pathways.
