

Design & Access Statement for ATM Installation E018248 ATM Cardtronics Cashzone

LSJ Supermarket 132 Darfield Road Cudworth Barnsley S72 8RJ

Introduction

This Design and Access Statement has been prepared on behalf of Cardtronics Cashzone in support of an application submitted for the installation of an Automated Teller Machine and illuminated signage.

The initial purpose of the proposal is to provide 24 hour banking facilities for customers using LSJ Supermarket Darfield Road Cudworth.

As this installation is for an ATM within the existing external façade, some aspects such as “layout” and “Access” are of limited applicability.

Design Principles and Concepts

Design

The site is a Convenience Store in Darfield Road Cudworth. The installed ATM provides direct and unobstructed access and has been installed in the window to the far right of the shop front through new white laminate security panels replacing the existing glazing. NCR 5887 ATM fascia and Cash zone green and black polycarbonate top sign with illuminated white lettering and halo illumination. At the top of the ATM fascia is a green acrylic Cash zone sign with white lettering and accepted card logos. The existing security roller shutter has been modified to allow constant use of the ATM. Two anti ram raid bollards have been installed in front of the ATM. Install Date 8th March 2016.

ATM fascia with Cashzone black and green polycarbonate top sign. Illuminated white lettering “free cash withdrawals and free balance enquiries”

Design Principals

The ATM is of a standard design as located in many areas throughout the UK and is accepted as a necessary facility. There are a number of mandatory standards which apply relating to the position of the ATM, it’s visibility, ambient lighting, building structure, security features, ATM anchoring and ATM safe security and strength.

Scale

The dimensions of the installation are:-

ATM fascia top sign is set at a height of 1558mm from the pavement level to the underside of the ATM fascia top sign.

Top sign Height 400mm. Width 715mm. Signage to top of ATM fascia in green acrylic with white internally illuminated lettering. Height 176mm Width 495mm

The display screen is carefully shielded from ambient lighting to prevent glare and reflection, ensuring a clear and sharp image is visual by both standing and seated users.

132 Darfield Road Cudworth is not believed to be within a Conservation Area or is a Listed Building.

Layout

The ATM has been installed at a suitable height in order that the cash dispenser can be easily accessed, in accordance with DDA regulations.

Landscaping

Due to the nature of the proposal, we feel the application will not benefit from any landscaping.

Appearance

The installed ATM is a standard NCR 5887 design with Cardtronics Cashzone black and green illuminated top sign with illuminated white lettering and halo illumination.

Access

The installed ATM has good access for the public. Due to the flat surface to the frontage and its position within the frontage.

The installation has been designed to anticipate and overcome the restriction that would prevent disabled persons from making full use of the service to be provided together with the needs of more vulnerable people from protection of attack and intimidation.

The ATM has been set at a height that makes it accessible for wheel chair users. Key 5 has raised markings for blind persons to identify the centre key.

There is sufficient area in front of the installed ATM for easy access and for pedestrians to pass an ATM customer without disturbance.

Crime Prevention

Cardtronics Cashzone carry out an end to end solution using Cash in Transit (CIT) and engineering staff, our security managers consider the following for every installation deliveries, parking outside the unit and line of sight of the replenishment for the staff.

Cardtronics Cashzone believe that their standard working practices and the implementation of the above crime prevention measures help to provide a safe and sustainable development.

The installed ATM has the principal benefit to the community of providing cash on demand to the customers of LSJ Supermarket Darfield Road Cudworth Barnsley.
