Yes, this morning!
I have discussed it with Steve and we are both of the same opinion; the reason for the dual application is to ensure that some symmetry is retained. It is considered that the 0.89m increase in footprint of 46 Greenside should be removed and the dormer windows be located equidistant within the roof plane which would further balance the pair of properties.
For a joint proposal, both properties would need to be located within the red-line boundary, a full planning application form submitted along with the fee of £339
