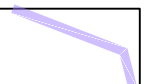


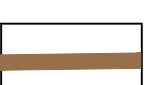


VEGETATION

PATHS AND PAVING

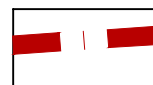
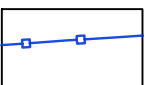
Penny Pie Park
