Electricity Act 1989: Overhead Lines (Exemption)(England and Wales) Regulations 2009

It is proposed to undertake the following work that is considered to be exempted from the Electricity Act 1989 by falling within the Overhead Lines (Exemption)(England and Wales) Regulations 2009:

Replace the existing open wire conductors in favour a Aerial Bunched Conductor

Particulars of proposed development to be completed by Applicant:

In order to improve the security of electricity supplies and also resolve any safety issues Northern Powergrid propose to erect Aerial Bunched Conductor (see attached photos) along the route of the existing overhead electric line. It is proposed to erect **31 meters** of Aerial bunched Conductor as shown coloured Red on the attached copy of drawing number YO09680. Aerial Bunched Conductor is deemed as the design successor of the existing open wire conductor
