

Re Development at Barugh Green /Redbrook/ Higham

I would like to express my objection to the above planning permission.

I have lived at
Barugh Green for 50 years.

When I purchased this property with my wife, we purchased it knowing the back of our property backed onto "green belt" fields.

I am objecting to this planning as my property is a bungalow and feel that I will now be somewhat overlooked as the planning appears to include, houses of both 2 and 3 storeys.

My light in my garden will therefore be reduced and I will lose the privacy from my garden.

At 86 I have limited mobility but at present am able to enjoy the privacy of my garden.

The value of my property will also be affected when these properties are overlooking me.

These are my objections personally, however as a community my further objection would be the traffic congestion.

City fibre have recently been installing pipes at the roundabout at Redbrook, this in itself has caused severe queuing on Huddersfield rd from Barnsley, Redbrook rd at the junction to Huddersfield rd and from Barugh green and darton.

The mini roundabout at Barugh which has recently been enlarged caused months of delays in all directions, so I can only imagine the months of traffic congestion in the area if this plan goes ahead.

The general highway safety will therefore be impaired and the general noise in the area will be significantly increased.

Further more Barugh Green rd at junction of claycliffe rd often floods with heavy rain and therefore will become far worse if the fields at the side become houses.
