The project includes internal modifications to deliver a new primary care streaming service. This involves the demolition and complete overhaul of the Emergency & Physio Department entrance as well as works to the consultation / exam rooms in the physio department. The Proposal is to provide the Hospital with a new singular entrance that opens into a circulation area. There will be an emergency department streaming desk and self check-in computers as well as a new combined physio and GP reception desks. The Physio and GP receptions now have their own separate waiting areas. Additional works also create new consultation rooms, offices, a staff room and modifications to the toilet/changing facilities. The proposed development will also provide the hospital with a new dedicated major incident store and changing facility.

However, the planning application is required directly related the the external entrance modifications and extension.

In order to avoid major disruption to these departments, construction will be phased so that areas can be completed and handed over to the client as time proceeds.

New external over cladding on the existing canopy with new signage is proposed. New cladding and render to the new small entrance extensions.
