### Consultation Assessment and Justification

The proposal is to install solar panels on the existing roofs of the Cranswick Convenience Foods buildings. Once the construction work is complete, there will be very few highway implications with the only traffic generation likely to be that to intermittently maintain the facility if and when required.

As such, the scheme is acceptable from the perspective of highway safety, but it is still important that the initial construction work is carried out safely. As such, HDC officers would ask that the below condition is added to the decision notice.

#### Consultation Suggested Conditions:

No development shall take place, including any works of demolition, until a Construction Method Statement has been submitted to, and approved in writing by, the Local Planning Authority. The approved statement shall be adhered to throughout the construction period. The statement shall provide for:-

- The parking of vehicles of site operatives and visitors;
- Means of access for construction traffic;
- Loading and unloading of plant and materials;
- Storage of plant and materials used in constructing the development;

In the interests of highway safety.
