

## Old Mounts Royston, 145 Midland Road Parking and Transport.

We don't anticipate any problems with parking due to the nature of the business but understand any concerns. We would expect majority of people to walk .

We will actively promote the bus route on social media as the proposed micropub is very well positioned for public transport (bus stops highlighted in red on supplied map please scroll down)

### Routes 59 and 59A

- These run between **Barnsley Town Centre (Interchange)** and **Wakefield City Centre**, via Royston.
- At the stop **Royston, adjacent to Midland Road / Alfred Street**, both routes serve Northwest-bound journeys to Wakefield with scheduled departures i.e 05:30, 06:30, 07:15 and so on. **Route 57**
- Operates between **Barnsley Interchange** and **Royston Meadstead Drive / Manor Grove**.

### Route 37S

Runs between **Carlton Holy Trinity** and **Monk Bretton Globe Holidays** including stops along Midland Road in Royston.

### Parking.

Midland Road in the area of the proposed micropub is double yellow lines along the side of the pub with restricted parking directly opposite. Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm we don't see this needed to be used but it is an option and would coincide with our expected busier times (see photo 1) (highlighted e on supplied plan)

The proposed micropub as parking at the rear in front of the garages on a drop curb which are owned by the landlord of 145 Midland Road who has given permission for parking. These do not restrict pedestrian crossing, cycle lane, or mobility access (See photo 2 highlighted d).

Appropriate signage will be displayed.

There is also a public car park less than 2 minutes walk away highlighted B on the supplied plan (photo 3 and 4).

There is parking for 3 cars on Midland Road with no restrictions marked F.


Area A (photo 6) usually has available parking in the hours of Old Mounts proposed opening times.

There is short term parking available highlighted pink on the supplied map (up to one hour)

Parking is also available after 6pm in the area marked C on the map (see photo5)



There is plenty of spaces available at the times we would be open as most of the other businesses in the area are closed or closing when we would envisage being our peak times (see enclosed opening hours chart)

## Conclusion.

Due to the nature of the business most of our customers are likely to walk, uses buses or taxis to the premises.
