## 3. Description of the Proposal

Please describe the proposed development including any change of use:

The site is currently vacant and has been used as a light industrial unit housing a small engineering company. No building works will be undertaken and will not be installing any machinery. There will be an internal redesign. The concrete floor will be covered by matting approved by World Taekwondo to form a safe training area. The existing internal office space will be used for offices and for storage of sports clothing and Taekwondo equipment. Part of the floor space will be configured as a waiting/viewing area with seats.

The roller door will not be used which will free up space internally and externally for extra car parking spaces.

Quest Taekwondo Penistone is a local sport organisation currently based at Penistone Grammar School ALC Sport Centre. It has 160 members, as it expands the sport centre cannot offer the necessary availability of times and space required. This unit has been identified as the only suitable alternative venue in the local area. Taekwondo sessions and related activities will be held at the Centre from 4-9pm Monday to Friday and 9am-5pm Saturdays and some Sundays. Sessions will consist of 12-20 participants.

One full time Coach and one full time receptionist will be employed immediately. In addition there will be 4 part time coaches and additional self employed support staff e.g. Physiotherapist, Strength and Conditioning Coaches. Quest is managed by a committee of 10 volunteers (including a Welfare/Child Protection Officer and Health and Safety Officer). We also employ approximately 20 support volunteers. As we become established in our new venue we will be increasing the number of full/part time employees and volunteers. There will also be the opportunity for sport and business interns from Sheffield Hallam University, Leeds Beckett University and Barnsley College.

Quest Taekwondo Penistone has been awarded Sport England's ClubMark Award and Great Britain Taekwondo's Talent Club status. As well as being a training venue for local people it will operate as the headquarters for the Quest Taekwondo Organisation with satellite groups in Liverpool, Dewsbury, Hull, Lincoln, Boston and Baildon. It will be a community sport club and also a High Performance Centre. As a High Performance Centre participants visit from all over the UK and abroad, bringing additional visitors to Penistone who use local shops and facilities.

The majority of participants will arrive by car. There is adequate parking for those vehicles staying on site, at least 14 dedicated spaces. Access to the site is via Sheffield Road (B6462), Longley Ings, Kirkwood Close. There will be no requirement for parking on these roads. Access is via a secured gate with neighbouring units fenced off. Occasional deliveries of stock will be made by vans/small trucks, not HGVs. There is a pavement to the boundary of the unit for pedestrian access.
