Large Sycamore tree, located in the green space next to the property. Right up to the boundary and over hanging.We are asking for a Sycamore tree to be cut back, not cut down. The closest branches are only 30 cm's from the houses roof tiles. The other branches of this tree are not far behind it. The leaf fall from the tree's continually blocks our guttering all year round, meaning we have to pay to get it cleared several times a year. There is also the risk of branches falling during severe winds. When we visit either the upstairs bathroom or downstairs toilet there is virtually no day light and the light has to be put on, even in the day time due to light deprivation caused by the tree. There is also a dying Sycamore tree next to this one so we always worry that this tree will fall or lose branches in inclement weather and may cause branches from the tree next to our property and cause it damage which then could damage our property.

There are also trees/bushes that need cutting back on the boundary to the rear of our property but these do not have a preservation on.

Tree species – Sycamore – Request to cut back 6 ft from the boundary fence.

TPO Tree reasons for the work – The branches are now very close to our roof, there is danger to the roof of our property due to the proximity of the tree and recent light deprivation after having no light deprivation for the first 20 years of living in our property. The danger is a risk from branches that will soon be touching our property and from falling branches in high winds. Also, there is a drying tree next to it, if the dying tree loses branches in high winds or because of decay it may have a knock on effect, causing the tree in this request to cause damage to my property.
