I wish to confirm that the Growth & Sustainability Directorate has now completed its search for the information which you requested by e-mail on 11 July 2023.

Your questions and my findings are as follows:-

The response itself has triggered some further questions we would like to ask/request via a formal FOI request please:-

1. How many affordable homes have been permitted (received planning permission) in the Borough's defined Western Villages since the adoption of the Barnsley Local Plan in January 2019?

Since the adoption of the Local Plan in January 2019, there has been 40 affordable units granted approval in the Western Villages.

2. Where permitted (received planning permission) which Villages were the affordable homes delivered in and what was the tenure of each of those properties?

Please see the following table for a breakdown of the Villages and tenures of the affordable housing granted planning permission since the adoption of the Local Plan in January 2019.


