

Hoodlands Farm - 2 Ponds Wildscapes Planning Application Hoodlands Farm, Fulshaw Lane, Penistone, S36 9FD

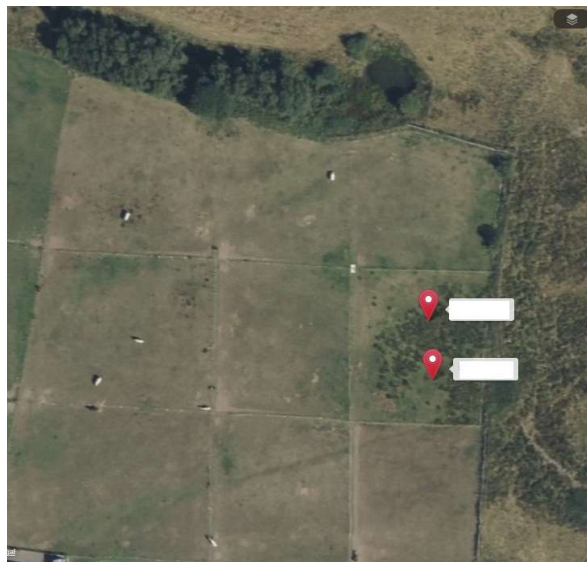
Landscape details

The Planning Portal has requested the submission of landscape details to support this planning application.

The landscaping work taking place is the creation of 2 new ponds which will be 1 meter deep and 150m² in surface area.

The field where the proposed ponds are located is defined as rough grassland, with a broadleaved woodland 42m north and a pond 48m north of the proposed pond locations. Invasive species are not present in the vicinity. The ponds themselves will be situated in a wet area, dominated by soft rush, deemed unsuitable for grazing.



There will be no planting undertaken around the pond, as natural vegetation like rushes will establish over time. If planting was deemed necessary later then plants would be sourced from local suppliers who follow biosecurity controls.

Archeology checks were conducted during the desk survey and highlighted ruins of a mid 17th century farmhouse/building 280m north of the proposed site. South Yorkshire Archeology Service was consulted and could not identify any archeological features or sites which the proposal would affect.
