Prior to the resubmission of this application, on the 30th June 2023, the applicant reinitiated pre-consultation discussions with the local planning authority, local ward councillors, and representing MP. Prior to the submission of a formal application, the applicant initiates pre-consultation discussions with the local planning authority. This provides an opportunity for the LPA to discuss development proposals and identify site specific issues.

Pre-application consultation letters and drawings of the proposal were sent to the LPA on 30th June 2023.

Any pre-application consultation comments received by the Agent will be passed on in full to the LPA for their consideration during the assessment and determination of the formal application.

The application has been proceeded with at this time, despite the pre-application consultation period being open, as this site is the reapplication for a previously discussed application with your authority, reference 2023/0366 Case Officer Georgina Brayford. During the course of determining this application, the Case Officer notified us that a local resident and Ward Councillor had asked to investigate whether the site could be moved west in order to further minimise residential impact. This was brought to our internal design team, which found that this adjusted location was suitable, hence the reapplication before you.

On 20th June 2023, via email discussing the progression of a new application at the new proposed site before you, Officer Brayford stated, "I can't see any issues with the new location, subject to highways approval." Given this, and as all other aspects of the design are materially unchanged, it was deemed appropriate to proceed with this application without waiting for pre-application response from the LPA. Further, no pre-application comments were received by the LPA on the original application. However, if any concerns or comments are brought forward for this adjusted site by your authority, these will be of course taken into consideration for the application and forwarded on to the Operator/Applicant and appointed Case Officer.

The applicant is keen to work with the LPA and local community to ensure the proposal is 'right first time' to secure funding for the critical network infrastructure. If the proposal cannot progress this area will be left without sufficient mobile phone coverage and capacity and will not benefit from the most up to date technologies available.

Any comments received to the agent will be passed on to the Operator/Applicant for consideration and sent to the appointed Case Officer for their records.
