

Thank you for the email below and sharing the attached.

We would have a concern that the hybrid application for residential development for 1,560 dwellings will have implications for access to Primary Care. The closest GP practice site would likely be the Barugh green branch of the Huddersfield Road Surgery. The building for the branch is very small. As can be seen on the attached map, the other closest practices would be in neighbouring villages such as Dodworth or alternatively towards Barnsley town centre.

We are currently in the draft stages of our primary care estates strategy, although the strategy has not been adopted as yet it is nearing completion and has identified this impact which would potentially cause significant increase in pressure on Primary Care Services if the potential numbers identified are registering with the local GP practices. Using the adopted multiplier of 2.21 patients per household, these developments may add potentially 3447 new patient registrations for the PCN practices. We note that this assumes that the residents of these homes are new to the area (which is therefore a 'worst case scenario' prediction). In respect of Huddersfield Road Surgery, this practice has a main site close to Barnsley town centre and the list size for the GP surgery including patients who use the branch is currently 13086. Therefore, a potential additional 3447 patients could increase the list size by 26%.

We are unsure as to who the email below was shared with, but are mindful of the wider impact on NHS services including an increase in activity to Barnsley Hospital and also community services in addition to the primary care perspective. These teams may also wish to comment. Are you able to advise if this email has been shared with them also? If not we have colleagues who we can pass this onto?
