

- CATEGORY A (GREEN) TREES  
Trees of high quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 40 years
- CATEGORY B (BLUE) TREES  
Trees of moderate quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 20 years
- CATEGORY C (GREY) TREES  
Trees of low quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 10 years, or young trees with a stem diameter below 150mm
- CATEGORY U (RED) TREES  
Trees which are identified but they cannot be realistically be retained as living trees in the context of the current land use for longer than 10 years
- ROOT PROTECTION AREA (RPA)  
Minimum area around a tree deemed to contain sufficient roots and rooting volume to maintain the trees' viability, and where the protection of the roots and soil structure is treated as a priority
- CATEGORY A TREE GROUP OR HEDGE
- CATEGORY B TREE GROUP OR HEDGE
- CATEGORY C TREE GROUP OR HEDGE
- # DENOTES TREE POSITION PLOTTED DURING TREE SURVEY USING GLOBAL NAVIGATION SATELLITE SYSTEM (GNSS) FOR TREES NOT SHOWN ON THE TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY OR ESTIMATED USING DISTANCE FROM KNOWN TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY FEATURES
