

Design and Access Statement for Proposed Cricket Pavilion, Shaw Lane, Barnsley

Surroundings

The proposal is to erect a cricket pavilion adjacent to the cricket ground at Shaw Lane. The site is a multi-purpose sports ground with a variety of sporting activities taking place. The club has gone through major developments over the last 10 years and the provision of a cricket pavilion is just another step forward in improving the facilities provided. At present cricket teams use a portakabin to change and shower with no independent hospitality facilities.

Access

Access to the site will not be affected and will remain off Shaw Lane, via the existing drive.

Design and Appearance

The building is a pre-fabricated sectional building bought second-hand from Barnsley Hospital. It used to be their crèche unit and is situated at the corner of Summer Lane and Pogmoor Road. The building is single storey with brick cladding and a low pitched tiled roof.
